



Wilding Park is out of action, so the plan is for interclub tennis to be played at (& hosted by) various clubs this season.

Canterbury Tennis will still be coordinating the interclub games but they require an indication as to the number of Senior and Junior teams and grades that will be entered for each club.

Seniors will host matches possibly on a 'home-and-away' basis with the host club determining the time of the match, e.g. Saturday afternoon, or in some cases possibly even on a Friday night. At this stage, it looks like all other grades will be played on Sundays, with Division 1 & 2 Men & Women being played on Sunday mornings and other grades, on Sunday afternoons. This arrangement will allow Junior tennis to continue on Saturdays. It may also be that some grades could play during the week – depending on the demand. This will all be further clarified in the coming weeks.

At stage, we need to give Canterbury Tennis an indication of our proposed teams, by 15 August for Senior teams and 29 August for Junior teams.

Final team entries will then be finalised about two weeks after the above dates.
